There will be changes to the legal entity – we are yet to know where industry training delivery will go

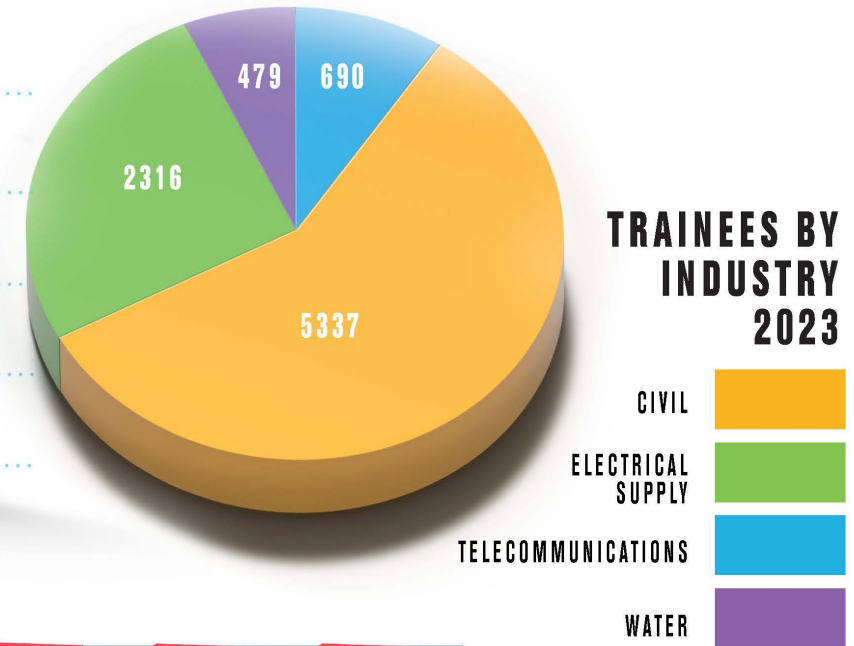
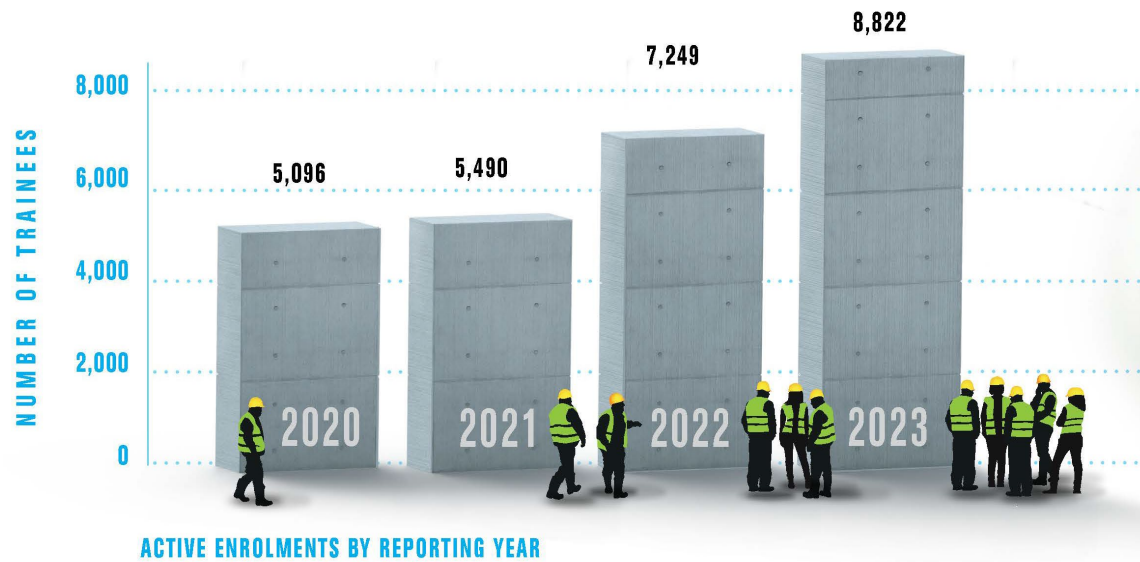

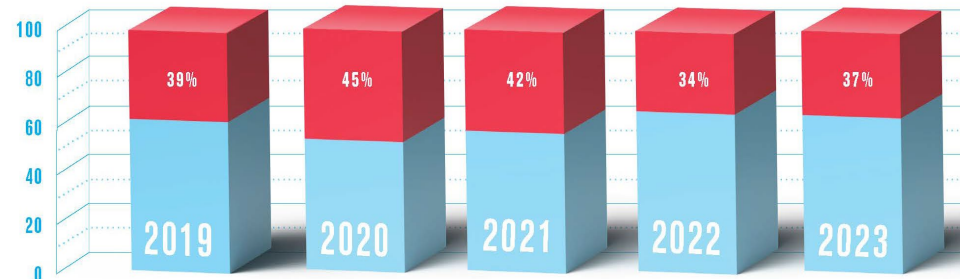
