What happened?

A machine operative was refilling an Auto Dump truck (ADT). As he was placing the hose the lid of the fuel bowser closed. The lid struck the operative on the back of the head, and the back of his shoulders.

The operative was wearing a bump hat; however, he was treated by First aider as a precaution.

No cuts or bruises were observed, and the operative went home.

The injured party (IP) later attended his local A&E hospital, he was treated for mild concussion.
