NZ ECP-34 Electrical Safe Distances & Close Approach Consent

Powerco have recently experienced several incidents where excavations and earthworks have taken place close to, and disturbed the land by, electricity poles or transformers.

This not only places our assets at risk of failure, but more importantly it significantly increases public safety risk and can cause significant damage to property.







