Staff Member Falls from Deck of Truck

Background

A staff member was in the process of tying down a power pole with rachet chain equipment. While applying force to tighten the rachet he has inadvertently lost balance, causing him to topple over the sideboard of the truck deck and fall 1.2m to the ground. Due to the awkward nature of the fall, he has regrettably suffered a fracture to the lower leg. Vault No. 5483

- Layout of truck decks

- Periodic maintenance checks of rachet load binders / tie down devices
