
## SHE ALERT Hypodermic Needle

What happened ?					

Our colleague was attending streetlight fault works in Weymouth, they removed the cover and started to inspect the connections. Whilst they were inspecting the column they felt a sharp scratch on the side of the hand. Our colleague checked their hand and noticed that a hypodermic needle had punctured the glove and was stuck in their hand. They removed the needle and attended the local A&E where they received a tetanus jab, and some testing was carried out.

- Streetlight columns
- Gates
- Entering substations
- Operating locks
