



## Daily Vehicle and Defect Checks

All drivers of ScottishPower commercial vehicles and pool cars are required to complete a "Driver Vehicle Check and Defect Report" form VC40. These checks must be completed daily prior to each employee first use of a vehicle, any defects found must be detailed and reported to the maintenance provider via 0141 614 9996, following the options to the correct service provider. These checks should be completed on the mobile FleetWave Driver Advanced app.



In addition to the ScottishPower Driver's Handbook, all new vehicles will come with a QR code which links to a vehicle user guide (see example QR code for a Ford Transit).
