What Happened?

During a connections project, a generator was required to ensure continuity of supply to a large number of customers. To do so, a 1000kVA generator was to be synchronised to the Live LV system. When a Litton connector would not mate at the generator tail, our contractor received an electric shock when cleaning the connector. Fortunately, he received no injuries and a VSI investigation is currently underway.

Actions

Staff are reminded that:

- Only staff and contractors that have been trained and authorised by UK Power Networks are permitted to manage the connection and synchronisation of generators to the Live LV System
- Holding the competency to 'Connect a Generator to Dead LV System' does not allow for the connection of a generator to the Live LV System, nor for the synchronisation of a generator.
- HSS 40 026f Temporary Synchronisation of Generator (Zero Synch) mandates that leads and connections shall be inspected prior to use and that the leads are connected to the generator first.

It is the responsibility of line management to ensure that all appropriate employees are issued with this Alert and their understanding of the contents is checked. This Alert will be subject to compliance audits after 14 days from the date of issue.



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An On-Site (Point of Work) Assessment shall be undertaken as required by HSS 40 026 Use of Temporary Generation, and the task should be discussed and understood by all parties prior to commencing work.

Only persons that hold the Competence:

- Authorised Person Manage: Generator Connection to Live LV System or
- <u>Senior Authorised Person Manage: Work On</u> and can demonstrate that they have been trained to manage the connection of generators to the Live LV System shall be permitted to manage the connection and synchronisation of generators.
