

## Safety Alert

# Driving in Snow and Ice

Weather events associated with snow, sleet, ice and frost increase the risk profile for all staff who drive to and from their workplace and who commute for work. Remember stopping distances are 10 times longer in ice and snow conditions.

#### Please see below for Road Safety Authority safe driving tips:

- 1. Make sure your vehicle is safe check tyres, wipers and lights are in good order.
- 2. Make sure you can see clear snow and ice from windscreen/windows and snow from roof.
- 3. Keep up-to-date with weather and traffic reports, local radio is often the best.
- 4. Drive slowly, accelerate, brake and manoeuvre gently.
- 5. Give yourself and others space on the road, expect the unexpected.
- 6. Use the highest gear possible to avoid wheel spin.
- 7. Beware of 'Black Ice'. Sheltered/shaded areas in low lying places need extra caution.
