Ban on Use of One Handed Chainsaws

There have been a number of fatalities and serious injuries in recent years due to the use of Top Handle and light Rear Handle Chainsaws. These saws are capable of being operated one-handed, and are only designed for use up in a tree by a trained tree care specialist. When used one-handed, the chainbreak will not be activated if kickback occurs, and there is an significantly increased risk of cuts to the neck, shoulder and upper arm.

THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS ARE REQUIRED

ESB NTs are no longer permitted to use any Top Handle and light Rear Handle Chainsaws, they are to be withdrawn from service immediately. This restriction applies to all Top Handle Chainsaws, to any Rear Handle Chainsaw with a guidebar of 12" or less, and specifically to the Stihl MS 210 (See Fig 1).

Network Technicians: If you have one of these Chainsaws in your possession, return it to your

Supervisor/Managers: Check all Chainsaws in your team & quarantine these saws immediately **Auditors/Inspectors:**

If you come across any of these Chainsaws, inform your Line Manager &

All quarantined saws are to be sent to Eddie Kiely, Fleet & Equipment, Rosbrien, Limerick for disposal.

A Company Standard on the use of Chainsaws is under development, and when published, this restriction will be subsumed into this new document.
