Serious Accident involving Fork Lift Truck

On 14th February 2020 a contractor was injured at our Lister Drive Depot by a fork lift truck.

Although this incident is still to be investigated, it has some similarities to the serious accident involving a lift truck at Cambuslang in 2012, when a member of the Logistics team sustained a serious injury when his foot became trapped under the rear wheel of a fork lift truck.

On average, lift trucks are involved in about a quarter of all workplace transport accidents. Vehicles striking pedestrians was the second highest cause of workplace fatalities in the UK in 2018/19.

This Express has been issued to raise awareness of this most recent incident and to remind staff of the control measures implemented following the incident at Cambuslang in 2012.



Recommendations and action points

- Always assess the risks of moving plant and vehicles, ensure adequate controls are considered and implemented.
- Wherever possible, **segregate** vehicles and pedestrians, consider the use of physical barriers.
- **Ensure** you are always in full view of the driver of the vehicle and in a place of safety away from plant/equipment.
- Be Seen Be Safe Wear Hi Visibility clothing

Always maintain a safe distance Make sure you are visible to the driver
