

FAULTY (DRUMMOND) MARTINDALE MTL20B TEST LAMP

OVERVIEW

We have been made aware that some (Drummond) Martindale MTL20B test lamps have developed a fault which prevents the lamps indicating correctly when testing between phases or at 120volts.

Two failure modes have been identified

- 1) The lamps indicating 400V do not operate
- 2) The lamps indicating 120V do not operate

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO

- All test lamps must be proven to work on a proving unit or known live supply
 - o before being used
 - o and after use to ensure correct operation
- Defective test lamps are :
 - Not to be used
 - o Reported to AIRLine
 - o Returned to logistics

DETAIL

The image below shows a faulty test lamp not showing the 400V is present.
