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## Description of Hazard/Incident *(What happened?)*

Toyota has identified that the spiral cables' electrical connection for the driver's side airbag module may become damaged over time. If this occurs, the airbag warning light will illuminate and the driver's airbag may not operate in the event of an accident.

## Extent of Impact *(Details of injury, environmental harm, equipment damage, etc.)*

In Service Toyota Hiluxs built between July 2004 through to December 2009 have been identified as impacted.

## Key Facts *(What are the key facts ?)*

If the defect occurs, the airbag may not protect the driver in the event of a collision.

## Actions *(Information on corrective actions implemented that may prevent harm and or assist others in preventing a similar occurrence)*

Managers and Supervisors are to ensure drivers are made aware of this HSE Alert and comply with the following:

- Impacted Toyota Hiluxs, which are displaying the airbag warning light are to be immediately taken to their local Toyota dealership for inspection and rectification;
- Toyota Australia to forward Recall Notices to Ergon Energy as parts become available; and
- Once notification has been received local FTSOs will arrange an inspection and rectification with impacted work groups at their nearest Toyota Dealership.
