NZTA Traffic Management Update

As a result of a tragic accident involving road workers, the NZTA has issued a nationwide directive that all planned work on State Highways with a posted speed limit greater than 65km/hr will now require speed restrictions to be put in place. This affects operations such as Shoulder Closed or vehicles displaying Road Inspection signage. This interim measure is effective immediately and will be reviewed by 15th April 2019. At this stage it is for State Highways only.



What we all need to do:

- 1. 50km/hr speed restriction signs must be erected for all activities on State Highways such as Shoulder Closed, pole inspections, planned switching etc.
- 2. Any site visits where the vehicle is within 5m of the road edge will require 50km/hr speed restrictions in place
