Incident	Description
Date incident happened	13/05/2016
Where it happened	Bell Rd, Awatea Subdivision, Whatawhata
What happened	A Northpower civil contractor's employee cut into an existing live LV cable in an attempt to make the excess cable they uncovered more manageable to install into its final location.
Why it happened	The civil workers deviated from the scope of work for the day – to excavate and expose the cable - when an excess loop of cable was discovered.
The important things you should remember about this	Always treat all cables as live unless they have been proven as dead and suitably isolated by a trained and competent person.
What you must do in future OR What will happen next	If physical site conditions change, the work party must stop and reassess the risks and document how to mitigate the new hazards. If there is any doubt, stop, push-back and seek advice from your Supervisor or Project Manager.
