



Safety Alert – SA249 **Head Injury due to lack of PPE**

Time	11:55
Injuries/Damage sustained	Open wound to forehead
Event Description	Whilst undertaking a Fibre Installation the installer was running conduit at the base of a wall. The installer found whilst leaning over their hard hat was falling off so the installer removed it and continued working. IP was fastening conduit to premise
	The hard hat was fitted with a chin strap but was not being worn correctly. Example of Chin strap across top of Hat not being worn appropriately

The installer then began fastening a conduit to a vertical section of the wall. The installer stood up from a crouched position and came in contact with sharp corner of Fascia Board.





Initial Actions Taken	Applied compression to wound and notified NPSAFE and Manager. IP sought Medical attention which resulted in stitches.
Actions Required / Messages	Always ensure you are wearing the correct PPE for the task you are performing. Ensure your hard hat has a chin strap fitted and you wear it where required. PPE Procedure Link
